The Registrant will render advice on U.S. laws, regulations, policies and proposed legislation, such as S. 1629, that may affect or relate to imports of pork products from Canada, arising out of the countervailing duty investigation conducted by the U.S. Department of Commerce and the International Trade Commission on live swine and fresh, chilled and frozen pork from Canada. The fee for such representation is to be determined periodically, as set forth in the attached correspondence, based on usual hourly charges and other criteria for legal fees, plus out-of-pocket expenses. The duration of the agreement is indefinite.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.


The Registrant has rendered and will render legal advice to the foreign principal with respect to U.S. laws, regulations, policies and proposed legislation, such as S. 1629, that may affect or relate to imports of pork products from Canada, arising out of the countervailing duty investigation conducted by the U.S. Department of Commerce and the International Trade Commission, and will engage in other activities as required in legal representation of the principal.

Dear Mr. Adams:

This will confirm the basis upon which the Canadian Meat Council and its members have retained our firm. You have requested and we have agreed that Arnold & Porter will represent the Canadian Meat Council and its members in the countervailing duty investigation being conducted by the United States Department of Commerce and the International Trade Commission on live swine and fresh, chilled and frozen pork from Canada.

With respect to this matter, the Canadian Meat Council has agreed that it will pay for our legal services in accordance with our usual and customary charges for matters of this nature, based primarily upon the amount of time and effort spent on your behalf. As we have discussed, we request an initial retainer of \$10,000, and our statement in this amount is enclosed. Fees will be charged against this amount and further statements for our services will be sent to you on a monthly basis.

It is also understood that, in addition to the amounts to be paid us for our services, the Canadian Meat Council will reimburse Arnold & Porter for out-of-pocket expenses incurred on behalf of the Canadian Meat Council, including such items as travel expenditures and living expenses when out-of-town, taxi fares, long distance calls, duplicating costs, etc. Statements for these disbursements will be sent to you on a monthly basis.
