In continuation of the arrangement between the Swiss Confederation and Arnold & Porter, concluded for the first time in June 1970, Arnold & Porter (the Firm) will provide general advisory services to the Swiss Embassy (the Embassy). These services will be provided by Robert Herzstein who can in agreement with the Embassy and if necessary, assign the task to other qualified personnel of the Firm. Within the Firm, Robert Herzstein will ultimately be responsible to the Embassy for the diligent execution of the services.

The Firm will on a quarterly basis send a statement to the Embassy for the services rendered during the previous quarter. The statement will identify the areas for which billing has occurred. Out-of-pocket expenses, such as cost for photocopying, messengers, and long-distance telephone calls will be included in the quarterly bills.

The amount charged for the above-mentioned services will not exceed US dollars 45'000.-- per year.

Projects that the Embassy requests and that entail substantial efforts by the Firm exceeding the budgeted retainer will be identified by the Firm prior to the execution of such requests. The appropriateness of a supplementary payment will then be discussed between the two parties.

The Firm will in accordance with its normal practice, continue to attempt to identify and avoid any conflict of interest between the Embassy and the Firm that might be presented by the Firm's representation of another client. In doubtful cases the Firm will consult with the Embassy.

This Agreement is concluded for a period of three years beginning January 1, 1988 and ending December 31, 1990. It can be terminated at any time if the basis for the relationship between the Embassy and the Firm should no longer exist.


