

Privacy Act Statement. This report is available to the public.

I am writing to confirm your appointment as an Agent of the Minister of Justice of Canada to provide advice on legal issues related to Canada-U.S. trade. This letter and the enclosed Department of Justice Memoranda of Instructions to Agents of the Minister of Justice constitute the terms and conditions of this appointment.

Services may be provided by attorneys other than those listed above provided that they are members or employees of Arnold & Porter and that their rates are comparable to rates fixed for attorneys of comparable experience.

The contract is effective April 1, 1991 and expires on March 31, 1992. The limit on expenditures is US \$50,000. Should you determine that your charges will exceed that amount, please inform me as soon as possible so that approval for the increased expenditure can be obtained.

Payment will be made upon submission of an itemized and certified account to this office. Your account should be certified as follows:



I would also ask that you continue to send copies of any opinions done under this contract to Mr. Marc Brault at the Canadian Embassy in Washington.


