The Registrant will advise the foreign principal with respect to U.S. laws, regulations and policies dealing with the distribution of commodity options in the United States. The fee for such representation is to be determined periodically based on usual hourly charges and other criteria for legal fees plus out-of-pocket expenses. The duration of the agreement is indefinite.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

The Registrant will advise the foreign principal with respect to U.S. laws, regulations and policies dealing with the distribution of commodity options in the United States. The Registrant will engage in political and other activities as required on behalf of the foreign principal, some of which may require registration under the Act.

6. Will the activities on behalf of the above foreign principal include political activities as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act?<sup>1/</sup> Yes  No

The Registrant will engage in political activity on behalf of the foreign principal. <sup>1/</sup> Political activity as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act means the dissemination of political propaganda and any other activity which the person engaging therein believes will, or which he intends to, prevail upon, indoctrinate, convert, induce, persuade, or in any other way influence any agency or official of the Government of the United States or any section of the public within the United States with reference to formulating, adopting, or changing the domestic or foreign policies of the United States or with reference to the political or public interests, policies, or relations of a government of a foreign country or a foreign political party.
