BARBADOS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

During the period under review, the activities of the Barbados Ind. Dev. Corporation continued to focus upon the encouragement of U.S. manufacturers to invest in Barbados. The main thrust of these activities continued to be (1) advertising the country as a desirable industrial location; (2) conducting interviews; (3) staging seminars through direct mail programmes; and, generally, to provide information services as a result of in-coming inquiries.

BARBADOS BOARD OF TOURISM

The office of the Barbados Board of Tourism was involved primarily in disseminating tourist literature with the aim of motivating and building a rhythm of travel to Barbados. This literature was sent out of the office along with films of Barbados. The office was also engaged on the broad level of educating travel agents, travel writers and travel trade in general on the facilities Barbados has to offer as a holiday destination. The office also held a series of seminars and presentations to put this into effect.

¹The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual.
