

This letter authorizes us to begin working on behalf of the Ministry of Fisheries and the Embassy of Mexico for an initial period of four weeks, to start upon receipt of your written authorization to proceed. This phase of work will cost \$50,000 not including foreign travel. The work will focus on research and analysis of international commercial fishing issues, and include public affairs and government relations counseling pertaining to these issues. This will include a planning meeting to discuss next steps.


