

Privacy Act Statement. 

Dear Dr. Marto:

This is to memorialize the terms of our understanding with respect to advisory services that AG Global Solutions will provide to the Ministry of Finance of the Kingdom of Jordan in connection with its upcoming Paris Club debt rescheduling negotiation.

The objective of this assignment is to help the Kingdom of Jordan achieve Paris Club debt rescheduling on the most favorable possible terms. Specifically, AG Global Solutions will assist the Ministry of Finance and other Jordanian authorities designated by the Ministry of Finance in its dialogue with the U.S., including with the Department of the Treasury, and other relevant Executive Branch agencies. The assignment may also include advisory support in Paris.

The assignment will be carried out in two phases. The first phase runs from the date of the signing of this letter agreement through June 30, 2002. Work for this phase will be centered in Washington, D.C. Prior to the end of the first phase, the Ministry of Finance in its discretion may extend the assignment until the signing of the Agreed Minute in Paris in July 2002. Work for this second phase is expected to take place in both Washington, D.C. and Paris, France.

The fee for each phase is sixty thousand U.S. dollars (USD 60,000.00). The first installment is due and payable upon signing this letter agreement. If the Ministry of Finance extends the assignment to the second phase, payment shall be due and payable on July 1, 2002. Fees for the first phase are inclusive of business expenses. Fees for the second phase are exclusive of business expenses (travel and accommodation) associated with the negotiation in Paris. Payment of such business expenses shall be due and payable within 30 days of the presentation of an invoice by AG Global Solutions.

If for any reason the final rescheduling negotiation is delayed (beyond July 2002), the parties may negotiate a further extension of this assignment on terms to be decided.
