

Colin,

Given our previous conversations, I thought I'd bring to your attention the attached letter. As you know, in 2007, the United Arab Emirates enacted a new export control law, known as Federal Law 13. UAE's Federal Law 13 is designed to work in tandem with U.S. efforts to inhibit the potential movement of sensitive goods and technology to Iran and other sanctioned destinations. The attached letter, from UAE Ambassador H.E. Yousef Al Otaiba, describes how the UAE's new law is working. Please don't hesitate to give me a call at 202 887-4133 if you want to discuss further.

We will be working with the Embassy on matters before Congress, but you should also feel free to reach out directly to Ms. Hagir H. Elawad, Director of Congressional Affairs at the UAE Embassy. Her contact information is as follows:

Dear Secretary Gutierrez:

In close cooperation with the US and other allies, the United Arab Emirates has dramatically tightened export control laws and enforcement to prevent the movement of illicit goods and materials across its borders. With the Arabian Gulf's largest seaport and airport, the UAE recognizes the need for extraordinary diligence and is committed to continually improving its own security and those of its allies by restricting illegal transshipments.

Specifically, the UAE fully supports and has vigorously enforced UN resolutions barring the shipment of sensitive materials and technologies to Iran. Over the last year, based on actionable intelligence about Iran-bound cargos in possible violation of transshipment rules, UAE authorities have stopped dozens of ships and inspected hundreds of shipments. Where there have been suspicious activities, UAE authorities have seized cargos and launched investigations. Among the examples since June 2008:

- Based on US intelligence, on September 4, UAE authorities impounded a Chinese shipment of specialized aluminum sheets that could be used in the manufacture of ballistic missiles.
- Based on US intelligence, on August 31, UAE authorities impounded a Malaysian cargo of specialized aluminum tubes that can be used for aeronautical and military purposes.
- At the initiative of UAE authorities, a Chinese shipment of titanium sheets bound for Iran was seized on August 14, pending further investigation.



- Based on German sources, on July 27, UAE authorities seized a Turkish shipment of advanced computers and determined that export papers had been forged.
- On June 25, UAE authorities impounded an Indian shipment of high-speed computers.
- Based on US intelligence, on June 20, UAE authorities seized sophisticated Swiss machine tools that could be used to manufacture nuclear components.

In August 2007, the UAE Government enacted and shared with US officials its new export control law that expanded enforcement and stiffened penalties. Among its provisions, the law:

- Restricts or bans the import, export, or re-export of goods deemed a threat to the UAE's national security;
- Bans the export or re-export of strategic goods, including arms and military hardware, chemical and biological materials, and dual-use items without a special license;
- Establishes a National Commission with clear oversight and management responsibilities for UAE export control procedures. This group was recently reorganized to streamline policy and enforcement coordination.

With this expanded legal authority, the UAE has closed dozens of international and local companies involved in the transshipment of dual-use and controlled materials banned under UN Resolutions and other international agreements.

Importantly, the UAE and the United States have worked closely together on stopping sensitive transshipments. The two governments have established an effective Counter Proliferation Task Force. There is regular sharing of intelligence, though in many previous cases, US information has not always proved to be actionable.

The UAE also participates in the US Container Security Initiative, in the Proliferation Security Initiative, in the US Department of Energy's Megaports Initiative, and in the Department of Homeland Security's Security Freight Initiative. The UAE allows UAE-based US customs officials full access to its seaports and airports to inspect US-bound cargoes.

Beyond export controls, UAE and the United States share a deep and common resolve to preserve security and stability in the region. US homeland security is tied directly to the UAE's security role in the Gulf.



- The UAE was the first country to support the United States at the advent of Desert Storm.
- A formal Defense Cooperation Agreement has been in place since 1994.

The UAE provides ongoing and essential support for US forces in the region:

- Hosting more than 2,000 US military personnel.
- Providing critical logistics support for US Navy fleet operations; more than 600 US Naval vessels visited UAE ports in 2006 with a 100 percent safety record—making UAE ports the most visited foreign ports for US ships.
- Supporting US Air Force operations through critical logistics and facilities at Al Dhafra Air Base.
- Supporting US and NATO missions in Afghanistan.
- Deploying UAE military forces and/or providing UAE assistance to Operation Desert Storm/Gulf War, Operation Iraqi Freedom, as well as UN Operations in Somalia and Kosovo.
- Hosting the Joint Air Warfare Center and joint training exercises with US forces.

The Embassy staff and I are available at your convenience to brief you in more detail about our export control initiatives specifically or the overall UAE-US relationship.
