



Answers for Exhibit B to Registration Statement

6. There existed no formal agreement between the Government of Indonesia and BSMG. The foreign principal-agent relationship between BSMG and the Government of Indonesia arose out of BSMG's representation of Mercurindo whose clients included the Government of Indonesia.

7. BSMG represented Mercurindo providing public relations services in the United States and abroad, including drafting, designing and producing information materials, planning and organizing events and seminars, and working with the news media through oral and written communications. During the course of this representation, and at Mercurindo's direction, representatives from Mercurindo and BSMG met with representatives of the Indonesian government. On other occasions, BSMG provided assistance to Mercurindo and Indonesian government officials on visits to the United States, including arranging meetings with United States business leaders and journalists.
