

Privacy Act Statement. 



SERVICES AGREEMENT

This is an agreement under which William J. Burhop, Esq. agrees to perform services on behalf of the Government of Romania.

EFFECTIVE DATE/TERM

The effective date of this agreement is February 1, 2002. The agreement will be effect until September 30, 2002. This agreement may be extended upon agreement by both parties.

SCOPE

For the term of this contract, under the direction of the Minister of Foreign Affairs, the Ambassador of Romania to the United States, and/or their designee(s), William J. Burhop will provide advice and consulting services concerning Romania's candidacy for membership in the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) and other projects as mutually agreed upon.

Services pursuant to this agreement will include, but not be limited to, advice, guidance, and support for strategic communications, public relations, advocacy and related activities in the United States to assist Romania's efforts to achieve their objectives in meeting NATO membership criteria and communicating developments in Romania to U.S. decision makers.

William J. Burhop will also assist in the organization and development of a Romanian-American Business Development Organization to enhance and expand the commercial, cultural and political relations among businesses and other entities in Romania and the United States.

REPORTS

William J. Burhop will provide the representatives of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Romania with reports on Romania's objective to join NATO as required. The focus of this report will be tailored to specific needs and interests.

COMPENSATION

During the term of this agreement, the Government of Romania will compensate William J. Burhop at the rate of \$10,000 (ten thousand US dollars) per month. Directly related out of pocket expenses such as taxis, FedEx, meals, etc. will be fully reimbursed at cost and based on a mutually agreeable level.

William J. Burhop will provide expense information that includes the necessary level of detail. Any out of area travel expenses will be reimbursed only if approved in advance.

SERVICES AGREEMENT

February 1, 2002

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PAYMENT

William J. Burhop will be paid in U.S. dollars in check form drawn on a bank chartered in the United States by Romania through the Embassy of Romania located at 1607 23rd Street, NW, Washington, DC 20008. Two payments of \$40,000 (forty thousand dollars) each will be made on the 1st day of February, 2002, and on the 1st day of June, 2002 prior to the provision of services for the succeeding 4 month period.

Approved expenses will be reimbursed within 60 (sixty) days after they are incurred and for which proper reports are filed, except for approved out of area travel which will be reimbursed within 30 (thirty) days of being incurred.

CONFIDENTIALITY


William J. Burhop agrees to take every reasonable step to prevent disclosure of any and all confidential information provided to him by Romania or to third parties. Confidentiality shall extend to all information deemed confidential by Romania whether provided by or on behalf of Romania or developed by William J. Burhop on his behalf.

TERMINATION

This agreement can only be terminated by Romania by providing 120 days written notice to William J. Burhop, or by William J. Burhop by giving 30 days written notice.

ENFORCEBILITY


This agreement will be fully enforceable and governed by the laws of the United States and in its courts of law.
