

Privacy Act Statement. Every registration statement, short form registration statement, supplemental statement, exhibit, amendment, copy of informational materials or other document or information filed with the Attorney General under this Act is a public record open to public examination, inspection and copying during the posted business hours of the Registration Unit in Washington, DC. 


The registrant fulfills its activities in accordance with the policy and instructions of the foreign principal. The registrant reports to the foreign principal on a regular basis on its activities.
