Registrant also acts to make information with respect to the Arab world available to the U.S. Activities of the registrant as administered through its staff members, by giving lectures to requesting groups, appearing on radio and TV interviews (as requested), answering by letters, telephones and personal contacts the requests for information made by the public and on occasion, sending letters to newspaper editors, showing (on request) available films on the culture and development of the Arab world and distributing publications which serve the aims described above.

¹The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual. (See Rule 100(a)(9)).
