Registrant is serving further the common interest and peaceful developments, trade, religion, cultural exchange and tourism. As indicated in the body of this report, we publish and/or disseminate materials, newsletters, advertise occasionally and some members of our staff lectures, all of which is duly recorded in the semi-annual report for each period.






