Registrant is serving as an Information Center of the League of Arab States to improve understanding between the Americans and the Arab people. Registrant is serving further the common interest and peaceful developments, trade, religion, cultural exchange and tourism. Registrant also acts to make information available, with respect to the Arab world, to the U.S. Activities of Registrant to groups, appearances on TV and radio interviews (as requested), answering letters, telephones, letters to newspaper editors, personal contacts, showing (on request) available films on the culture and development of the Arab world and distributing publications which serve the aims described above.

¹The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual. We also present the just aims and the struggle of the Palestinians and to restore their right to freedom and self-determination.

As indicated in the body of this report, we publish and/or disseminate materials, newsletters, advertise occasionally and some members of our staff lectures, all of which is duly recorded in the semi-annual report for each period.


