Registrant is serving as an Information Center of the League of Arab States to improve understanding between the Americans and the Arab people. Registrant is serving further the common interest and peaceful developments, trade, religion, cultural exchange and tourism. Registrant also acts to make information available with respect to the Arab world, to the U.S. Activities of Registrant to groups, appearances on TV and radio interviews (as requested), answering letters, telephones, letters to newspaper editors, personal contacts, showing (on request) available films on the culture and development of the Arab world and distributing publications which serve the aims described above.

We also present the just aims and the struggle of the Palestinians and to restore their right to freedom and self-determination.

As indicated in the body of this report, we publish and/or disseminate materials, newsletters, advertise occasionally and some members of our staff lecturers, all of which is duly recorded in the semi-annual report for each period.




