


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FOREIGN AGENTS REGISTRATION ACT OF 1938, AS AMENDED

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TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

I have the honor to report on the administration of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended, pursuant to Section 11 of that Act, which requires the Attorney General from time to time to report to the Congress concerning the administration of the Act, as well as the nature, source and content of political propaganda disseminated or distributed by agents of foreign principals registered under the terms of the statute.

Although the Act by its terms requires a report "from time to time," it has been the policy of the Department since 1950, to prepare a report each year in the light of the widespread interest expressed by Members of the Congress, the press and the public in the identity and activity of persons acting within the United States as agents of foreign principals.

This report deals with the administration and enforcement of the Foreign Agents Registration Act

for the calendar year 1957, and is in supplement to the reports submitted for the calendar years 1955 and 1956. A report covering the five-year period commencing January 1, 1950 and ending December 31, 1954, was submitted in June 1955.

The year 1957 was one of the most active the Department has experienced in the postwar years. More statements were filed during 1957 and more active statements were on file at the close of the year than at any other time.

STATISTICAL SUMMARY

In 1957, a total of 107 registration statements were filed and 46 terminated leaving 368 active registration statements on file as of December 31, 1957. This compares with 63 statements filed during 1956, and 307 active statements on file as of December 31, 1956. An alphabetical list of the registrants who filed during 1957 together with the name of the foreign principal and a brief description of the nature of each agency is contained in Appendix II, while a list according to registration number will be found in Appendix I.

During the calendar year 1957, 402 short form registration statements were filed by partners, officers, directors or other persons rendering assistance to

registrants which are partnerships, corporations, associations, organizations or other combinations of individuals, for or in the interest of the registrant's foreign principal. In comparison, 290 short form registration statements were filed in 1956. Short form registration statements are listed in Appendix IV. The identity of the registrant in support of whose statement a short form registration statement was filed may be ascertained by reference to Appendix I through correlation of the registration number.

As has been the case in previous years, the largest number of new registration statements was filed by persons engaged in publicity, public relations, advertising, or allied activities on behalf of foreign principals. It was noted in 1957, however, that an increasing number of registration statements are being filed by travel bureaus and agencies engaged in the promotion of tourist traffic to Soviet-bloc countries. Another large class of registrants consists of those engaged in legal and economic consultant services. A table showing the classification of statements according to the principal function reported will be found in Appendix III.

NATURE, SOURCE AND CONTENT
OF POLITICAL PROPAGANDA

As in past years, the largest source of political propoganda continues to emanate from official foreign government information and tourist offices. This material is designed primarily for the promotion of good will and to present to the American public particular viewpoints on various national and international issues. It is also designed to stimulate trade with and travel to foreign lands, and the expenditure of over seven million dollars and the employment of 662 persons in the United States by official government information and tourist offices continues to reflect the importance placed by these governments on American trade and tourism to help the economies of these countries. A table showing the expenditures and number of employees of all foreign government information and tourist offices registered under the Act will be found in Appendix VI.

Foreign governments continue to employ the services of American public relations concerns for advice as to the nature and content of their political propoganda material and a number rely upon American law firms for advice and consultation on their relationships with the United States and the policies to be pursued by them.

Appendix VII contains a summary showing the amount of money received by American individuals and organizations from their foreign principals during the calendar year covered by the report. Included in this listing are the names of American public relations advisers and consultants who have been retained by foreign governments during 1957. A list of registered agents whose statements were in an active status as of December 31, 1956, set forth according to geographical area or nationality field will be found in Appendix V.

The stream of propaganda material will ebb and flow in accordance with the intensity of the issues facing the foreign government or foreign political party which is trying to influence American public opinion. Thus, as the French Algerian crisis deepens, it can be expected that more propaganda material in regard to this issue will be disseminated within this country. Similarly, it is expected that the civil conflict now within Indonesia will during the present year be the stimulus for increased dissemination of propaganda.

No official government information or tourist offices are maintained by the Soviet Union, Bulgaria, Hungary, Rumania, Poland or Czechoslovakia. On the other hand, the Soviet Union, Poland, Rumania and Czechoslovakia have relaxed travel restrictions and

have appointed a number of domestic travel agencies for the purpose of arranging the necessary travel details and some of these, it is expected, will have available for distribution material designed to attract the American tourist. In addition, considerable Soviet-bloc material is imported and sold here by the Four Continent Book Corporation and Imported Publications and Products. Both of these operate as subscription agents for Soviet-bloc publications and utilize other bookstores as outlets for the material imported.

Following is an analysis of the principal trends noted during 1957 in the propaganda materials of the nations listed below:

Latin America. One of the principal sources of propaganda concerning the Latin American area has centered around efforts by groups to overthrow the Batista Government in Cuba, carried on largely by various organizations in the United States dedicated to this purpose. The major theme is to arouse support for the regime from Cubans in this country and from persons of Cuban extraction. Emphasis is placed on influencing American public opinion to terminate the shipment of arms to Cuba which, it is alleged, are used by the Government forces against the revolutionary forces of Fidel Castro. This propaganda material takes the form

of news periodicals, press releases, leaflets, and signs used for picketing. These organizations also urge citizens to write to their Congressmen to protest the arms shipments to Cuba. The Batista Government of course has a number of agents who attempt to get the regime's point of view before the American public. Their propaganda material is directed mainly against the Castro forces and other opposition leaders, but is also aimed at inspiring confidence in and good will toward the Cuban Government.

Dominican Republic. The Dominican Republic maintains an official government information office, known as the Dominican Republic Information Center, in New York City, and this agency is responsible for the bulk of Dominican propaganda disseminated within this country. The material takes the form of press releases and pamphlets. In addition, a White Book was issued on the subject of communist aggression in the Caribbean area which emphasized the role of the Dominican Republic in opposing this threat to the welfare of the Central American countries. A number of news releases concerned themselves with the disappearance of Jesus de Galindez, a former Columbia University professor, and the death of an American citizen, Gerald Lester Murphy, in the

Dominican Republic. This material of course attempted to refute the charges made that the Dominican Republic was implicated in this matter. In this connection, stress was placed on the appointment of the well-known attorney, Morris Ernst, by the Dominican Government to conduct an investigation of the Galindez case and the report which Mr. Ernst would render on his findings.

Other propaganda material emanating from Latin America deals with the encouragement of American investment in those countries and, as to be expected, with advertising of tourist attractions.

Middle East. *The Arab Information Center, the principal source of Arab propaganda, disseminated a variety of publications touching upon all phases of Arab economic, political, cultural and religious life. Included in these are press releases, a magazine called "The Arab World" and a news bulletin entitled "Arab News and Views."*

The intervention of the British in Oman was the object of much concern in the Arab world and was evidenced by the numerous articles which appeared in the publications disseminated by the Arab Information Center, which alleged that the British attack was launched in order to establish a legal basis to nullify the concessions and exploitation rights granted by the

Sultan to a British company. According to the Arab articles, the campaign was financed by the British Iraqi Petroleum Company whose object, it was claimed, was to occupy the particular region believed to possess great deposits of oil. Britain is accused of subjecting the Yemenite citizens to ruthless military attacks for the purpose of terrorizing them so as to increase Britain's colonial foothold on the Southwestern tip of the Arabian peninsula.

In many of the articles there is expressed the hope that the Arab countries will come to an understanding with the West over the Arab problems, generally, however, with the reservation that the solution to the disturbances in the Middle East does not lie in the Baghdad Pact or the Eisenhower Doctrine.

Israel. The Israel Office of Information continues to disseminate the "Israeli Digest," a biweekly publication dealing with the current economic achievements and political problems of the State of Israel. In addition there are numerous pamphlets on the subject of Gaza and the Gulf of Aqaba. In addition to these two issues, considerable material was disseminated to support the claim put forth by Israel that Egypt has organized and trained the Fedayeen as a military force for the purpose of taking vengeance on Israel.

North Africa. An organization within the United States known as the Algerian Front of National Liberation which names in its registration statement an organization of the same name with headquarters in Cairo, as its foreign principal, disseminates a newsletter entitled "Free Algeria," a series of pamphlets called "The Question of Algeria - A Background Document" and other publications relating to the Algerian struggle with France. In these publications it is alleged that the French authorities in Algeria are committing outrageous acts of terror as a matter of policy to suppress the liberties of the Algerian people. It is further alleged that French action in Algeria is considered such as to constitute the crime of genocide.

France. The French Embassy and other official French information offices in the United States have of course distributed considerable material presenting the French point of view with regard to the struggle in Algeria. The material disseminated by the French Government Tourist Office deals primarily with tourist attractions, while a biweekly report known as "France Actuelle" features articles on economic progress and political events. Included among the topics touched upon were the European Common Market, increased Franco-American trade and France's alliance with the United States.

Turkey. The bulk of Turkish propaganda is disseminated by the Turkish Information Office and deals primarily with Turkey's position in regard to the Cyprus dispute. Articles appearing in the publication "News From Turkey" also stressed Turkish-American cooperation and reflected Turkish appreciation for American aid and support.

China. The Chinese News Service is the principal source of political propaganda disseminated on behalf of Nationalist China. The Service publishes a weekly news bulletin together with special news releases and a digest of American press opinion on matters of interest to the Nationalist Government. The Service covers a wide range of publications with particular emphasis on material dealing with opposition to Communist China. Considerable space is given to the resistance movement and conditions in Communist China as well as to material opposing the admission of Communist China to the United Nations.

Political propaganda concerning Communist China is disseminated by Imported Publications and Products of New York, a registered agent. This material is in the form of periodicals and books, many of which are published by the Foreign Language Press of Peking. The periodicals deal with such subjects as the economic, cultural, social and political aspects of Communist

China while the books and pamphlets deal principally with the doctrines and policies of the Communist Party of China as expressed by its leaders and officials.

India. Political propaganda regarding India continues to be issued by the Embassy and the Information Service of India in the form of press releases, news bulletins and magazines. In this material considerable space was given to the dispute with the Government of Pakistan over the territory of Kashmir, the disarmament issue, and the proposed ban on nuclear tests.

Indonesia. The Embassy issues a magazine known as "Report on Indonesia," which contains news and views relating to its internal economy and foreign relations. Special releases were issued regarding the West Irian territorial dispute with the Government of The Netherlands.

Korea. The Korean Affairs Institute, Inc., registered agent of the Korean Government, issues a bulletin type publication entitled "Voice of Korea," while the Korean Pacific Press, another agent of the Government, issues a magazine entitled "Korean Survey." The "Voice of Korea" contains items dealing with Korean politics and includes articles regarding such subjects as Korean unification and admission to the UN. "Korean Survey," in addition

to giving a digest regarding the news of Korea, touches on Korean history, culture, economics and foreign relations.

Great Britain. Of all the registered agencies, the British Information Services disseminates the greatest volume of propaganda. Through the media of printed matter, radio broadcasts, television, and lectures, the British Information Services has touched upon practically every phase of the economic, social and political life of the people of the British Commonwealth. A review of the 1957 propaganda reveals that Great Britain was primarily concerned with the problems of the Middle East, Cyprus, Muscat and Oman, disarmament, and the Baghdad Pact. It was also evident from the special pamphlets and newsletters which were disseminated by BIS that the British viewed the independence of Ghana and Malaya as a great achievement for these former colonies, and there is a promise that one by one, as fast as conditions permit, other British colonies will receive their independence.

The British Information Services distributes daily a summary of the principal comments published in British newspapers, "as a service to those interested in current British opinion," and which it entitles "Today's British Papers." This daily summary reflects the attitude taken

by the British press on matters respecting events in the Middle East during 1957. For example, the Daily Mail in commenting on Israel's decision to withdraw from the Gaza Strip and the Gulf of Aqaba, stated that the decision was one that was generally welcomed.

In connection with the Cyprus problem, comments by the Daily Telegraph and the Manchester Guardian indicate that British interest in Cyprus is no longer of paramount importance, but that a solution regarding the Cyprus question is a matter of considerable urgency. For example, the Daily Telegraph stated that "British interest in Cyprus, though limited, is still perfectly plain," while the Manchester Guardian stated "it is now becoming generally accepted that sovereignty over Cyprus is no longer a British interest even from a military point of view."

The operations by British forces in support of the Sultan of Muscat and Oman during 1957, was not without criticism by the British press. The affair was viewed by some observers as a gift to the propaganda services of Cairo and Moscow and also as an event which may well feed the fires of anti-imperialist prejudice.

U.S.S.R. Soviet propaganda, as revealed in magazines, pamphlets, newspapers and books disseminated by Imported Publications and Products and Four Continent Book Cor-

poration, both of which are registered under the Act as agents, among others, of *Mezhdunarodnaya Kniga*, the All-Union Soviet Book Combine, attached great significance to the year 1957 as marking an important milestone in forty years of socialist progress and capitalist decline. It either glossed over or attempted to interpret to its advantage the failures the Soviet Union has registered in implementing its domestic and foreign policies.

According to this propaganda, the achievements of Soviet science and engineering, as shown by the launching of the two *Sputniks* and the first super-range intercontinental missile, have, it is asserted, dispelled the myth of United States scientific, technical and military superiority. As a result, the Soviets claim through their propaganda that NATO is in a state of acute political and military crisis and resentment in Europe is steadily mounting against the United States. Those facets of international relationships and activities which strengthen the NATO alliance are ignored.

The Soviet Union is pictured in its propaganda as constantly striving for peace despite the unremitting opposition of what it described as Western reactionary imperialist forces. It is for the purpose of achieving

peace and relaxing world tensions, according to this propaganda, that the Socialist camp advocates a summit conference of the heads of government. Only in this way, it is claimed, can differences be ironed out and peaceful coexistence established. Western views regarding this meeting, if mentioned at all by Soviet propagandists, are colored to strengthen Soviet claims.

According to Soviet propaganda, the capitalist world is on the decline, and is filled with corruption and dissension, with each partner willing to sacrifice the other to seek his own advantage. Soviet propaganda points to the alleged misgivings American leaders themselves feel concerning the state of the American educational system when compared to the success achieved by Russia in this field. According to some Soviet publications, the rest of the world, which is yet uncommitted to either side, is beginning to recognize this decline and they cite as evidence the fact that the Afro-Asian peoples are turning gradually to the Socialist camp which, the propaganda claims, understands and furthers their aspirations for independence and freedom. From all this it is argued that the future can only belong to the Soviets.

Soviet propaganda with respect to the Middle East alleges that the economic and military aid offered by

the United States to the Middle East countries is ostensibly for the purpose of protecting their "territorial integrity and political independence" against "danger from international communism." The propaganda claims that what is carefully concealed is the fact that the fundamental purpose of the Eisenhower Doctrine is to enslave the Middle East countries, to enable the American monopolies to lay hands on them, their natural wealth, their raw materials and markets and their populations, and to seize the positions the British and French colonialists once held or still hold. On the other hand, say the Soviet writers, the Soviet Union is interested only in insuring a stable peace in an atmosphere of trust in the Middle East. No mention is made of Soviet imperialist ambitions in this area.

Japan. The Consulate General of Japan at New York City and the United States-Japan Trade Council (formerly known as the Council for Improved United States-Japan Trade Relations) were the sources which disseminated political propaganda on behalf of this country. The Consulate issued a bulletin type publication called "Japan Report," which dealt principally with subjects concerning the government's foreign and domestic policies, trade relations and the suspension of nuclear

tests. The United States-Japan Trade Council issued both press releases and booklets dealing with the importation of Japanese woolen and cotton goods and the tariff problems connected therewith. Special emphasis was placed upon the action of the Japanese Government in imposing a voluntary control upon its exports of these goods to the United States.

ENFORCEMENT

Two prosecutions instituted for violation of the registration provisions of the Foreign Agents Registration Act were successfully concluded prior to the making of this report.

John Joseph Frank, a Washington attorney, was indicted on May 13, 1957, in a four-count indictment charging in substance that he acted within the United States as an agent of the Dominican Government and General Rafael Leonidas Trujillo, without having filed the registration statement required by the Act. Trial commenced on November 18, 1957, and on December 9, 1957 the jury returned a verdict of guilty on all four counts. The trial judge sentenced Frank to eight months to two years on each count, the sentences to run concurrently. The case is now pending on appeal.

In June 1956, a two-count indictment was returned by a Federal Grand Jury sitting in Detroit, Michigan,

against the Rumanian-American Publishing Association and its officers, wherein it was charged that the Association unlawfully and wilfully acted as an agent of the Government of the People's Republic of Rumania without having filed the registration statement required by the Act. The officers were charged with unlawfully failing to cause the organization to register. On February 26, 1958, Judge Frank A. Picard in the Federal District Court in Detroit imposed a fine of \$2,000 upon the Publishing Association following its plea of nolo contendere to the indictment. Prior to the acceptance of the plea, the Association had executed and filed the required registration statement.

The Association, which publishes a weekly Rumanian language newspaper called "Romanul-American," had been charged with acting as a publicity and propaganda agent for the Rumanian Ministry of Cultural Affairs. In its registration statement the Association named as foreign principals the Committee for the Cultural Establishments of the Rumanian People's Republic, and an organization called Cartimer, both in Bucharest. It described its activities on behalf of its foreign principals as publishing a weekly newspaper and an annual calendar, which publications present a working-class point of view and are primarily intended to be read by persons

of Rumanian origin in this country as well as in other countries including Rumania.

Other than the above two cases where it was found necessary to institute criminal proceedings for failure to register, compliance with the Act by persons acting within the United States as agents of foreign principals was obtained through normal administrative procedures.

Registration under the Act does not imply recognition by the United States Government either of the de jure existence or legality of the foreign principal nor does registration indicate approval by the United States Government of the propaganda material disseminated by the registered agent.

The principal purpose of Congress in enacting the Foreign Agents Registration Act was to require public disclosure by persons engaging in propaganda activities and other activities for or on behalf of foreign governments, foreign political parties and other foreign principals, so that the Government and the people of the United States may be informed of the identity of such persons and may appraise their statements and actions in the light of their associations and activities. The emphasis of the Department of Justice in its administration of the statute has

been toward the achievement of this purpose. In performing its functions, the Department has continued to rely upon its usual sources of information and upon the investigative efforts of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
