The Registrant will render advice on U.S. laws, regulations and policies that may affect or relate to the activities of the foreign principal, including representing the foreign principal with respect to proposed Congressional legislation which would extend Section 8e of the Agricultural Adjustment Act to table grapes and with respect to the issuance of regulations which would have an impact on table grape imports. The fee for such representation is to be determined periodically based on usual hourly charges and other criteria for legal fees, plus out-of-pocket expenses. The duration of the agreement is indefinite.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

The Registrant will render legal advice to the foreign principal with respect to U.S. laws, regulations and policies that may affect or relate to the activities of the foreign principal and will engage in other activities as required in legal representation of the principal.

DEAR FRED:

THIS IS TO CONFIRM OUR TELEPHONE CONVERSATION OF YESTERDAY. THE TABLE GRAPE GROWERS ASSOCIATION OF SONORA, MEXICO, WOULD LIKE TO RETAIN US TO REPRESENT IT IN EFFORTS TO DEFEAT PROPOSED CONGRESSIONAL LEGISLATION WHICH WOULD EXTEND SECTION 8E OF THE AGRICULTURAL ADJUSTMENT ACT TO TABLE GRAPES AND IN EFFORTS TO PREVENT THE ISSUANCE OF REGULATIONS PURSUANT TO A PROPOSED AGRICULTURAL MARKETING ORDER WHICH WOULD HAVE A DISCRIMINATORY EFFECT ON IMPORTS. WE WOULD BE HAPPY TO UNDERTAKE SUCH REPRESENTATION.

ARNOLD AND PORTER WILL BILL THE TABLE GRAPE GROWERS ASSOCIATION ON A MONTHLY BASIS. THE AMOUNT OF OUR FEES WILL BE DETERMINED PRIMARILY BASED UPON THE USUAL HOURLY RATES FOR OUR WORK AND OTHER FACTORS RELEVANT TO FEE DETERMINATIONS. WE WILL ALSO CHARGE FOR OUR OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSES. FOR AT LEAST THE FIRST MONTH WE WILL TRY TO GIVE YOU WEEKLY ESTIMATES OF THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF OUR FEES SO THAT YOU WILL BE ABLE TO IMPOSE ANY CONTROLS OR RESTRICTIONS THAT YOU FEEL MAY BE NECESSARY.

WE WILL BEGIN WORK ON THIS MATTER PROMPTLY AND KEEP YOU ADVISED OF OUR ACTIVITIES. WE WILL PROBABLY NEED A SUBSTANTIAL AMOUNT OF INFORMATION FROM THE ASSOCIATION AND WILL BE SENDING YOU A LETTER IN THE NEXT FEW DAYS REQUESTING IT. WE WILL ALSO SEND YOU THE MATERIALS YOU REQUESTED ON THE TOMATOES CASE AND THE AGRICULTURAL ADJUSTMENT ACT. WE WILL NEED TO REGISTER UNDER THE U.S. FOREIGN AGENTS REGISTRATION ACT AND LOBBYING ACT. TO DO SO WE NEED THE PRINCIPAL ADDRESS OF THE ASSOCIATION.
