The following should be added in response to Item 15(a):

The disbursement of \$36,085 on April 28, 1982 to Pandick Press was for the printing of legal documents used in an export financing transaction.

All travel expenses were incurred solely for the purpose of meeting with foreign principals, except as follows:

The May 14, 1982, May 24, 1982, and April 28, 1982, travel expenses on behalf of the Government of Israel were incurred for the purpose of meetings in New York with investment bankers relating to possible financing. The travel expenses on behalf of the London Commodity Exchange Company Limited, Metal Market and Exchange Company, Ltd., London International Financial Futures Exchange Limited, London Gold Futures Market, Ltd. were incurred for the purpose of attending the Third Annual Conference of the Commodities Law Institute sponsored by Chicago-Kent College of Law and a meeting of the Futures Industry Association.
