



Further to Mr. David Brown's letter to you of September 16, 1986 and your subsequent telephone conversations with Greg Blue of this Department, I am writing to confirm that you have agreed to act on behalf of the Province of Saskatchewan in connection with apprehended proceedings under U.S. trade legislation against Saskatchewan potash exports.
