Quebec Government House In New York is maintained to establish close ties between the authorities and people of Quebec, on the one hand, and their American neighbors, on the other hand, with a view to promoting friendly cultural relations and business and financial contacts on a mutual basis.. Organized under the Ministry of Intergovernmental Affairs, Quebec Government House in New York is the agency through which the various Departments of the Quebec Government may communicate with interested persons or institutions in the U. S. A very important function of Quebec Government House in New York is to maintain the closest possible communication with the New York financial community. The Department of Industry and Commerce also employs the facilities of the Quebec Government House in New York to promote two-way trade between Quebec and the U.S. as a whole and to encourage and assist American industries in manufacturing their products in Quebec. The Department of Tourism, Fish & Game likewise employs the facilities of Quebec Government House in New York to acquaint prospective American tourists with vacation and other recreational possibilities existing for them in the Province of Quebec. An Information Office in Quebec Government House in New York also attempts to answer newspapermen's queries about Quebec and in other cases to promote an understanding of Quebec People and institutions among the editors and top writers of leading U.S. newspapers, magazines and other information media. From time to time Quebec Government House in New York is instrumental in bringing Montreal and other Quebec artists in New York and elsewhere in the U.S. in an effort to develop friendly cultural ties between Quebec and the U.S.

¹The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual. (See Rule 100(a)(9)).

A registrant who represents more than one foreign principal is required to list in the statements he files under the Act only those foreign principals for whom he is not entitled to claim exemption under Section 3 of the Act. (See Rule 208.)
