

LOS ANGELES

1) Québec Government

For the benefit of local business associates, two breakfast meetings were arranged on December 13 and 14 to discuss the November 15 election in Québec and to introduce the new government.

2) Department of Intergovernmental Affairs

This office was consulted on the creation of ' La Fondation Prudent Beaudry ', a charitable educational and cultural organization.

3) Department of Industry and Commerce

The following trade development activities were initiated or supported by the office:

- A sales mission of 6 Québec electronic firms in the Los Angeles and San Francisco areas from September 15 through 24, 1976.

- Continuing assistance to major defense contractors and sub-contractors in their sourcing efforts on major Canadian programs such as the LRPA. During the period or review the office has assisted Lockheed, ITT Gilfillan, Aeronutronics Ford and TRW and other smaller firms.

- A technical mission of 7 Québec manufacturers at Wescon, in Los Angeles, September 12-16, 1976.

- Assisted some 30 Québec manufacturers in their marketing efforts on the west coast, with emphasis in the food, fashion and furniture areas.

- Assisted local consultants and corporate officers in various industrial development projects involving Québec.

- Provided assistance and opinions on product labeling for distribution in Québec.

4) Department of Tourism, Fish and Game

This year again the Québec Department of Tourism and the Québec Winter Carnival sponsored a float in the Annual Tournament of Roses parade, on January 1st, 1977. Promotional visits and receptions were arranged for the Bonhomme Carnaval, the official host of this annual event, for travel editors and travel agents.
