

Under a signed contract dated 7/20/80 (filed with the Justice Department 10/19/80) World Magazine Communications, Inc. has contracted with the registrant for distribution in the United States of film packages acquired. The Republic of Cameroon program (reported terminated 12/31/84 on our April 19, 1985 filing) is being reactivated and the registrant has arranged for transmission via Modern Satellite Network, RCA SATCom 3R, of a new title, CAMEROON TODAY, to a network of approximately 507 affiliates serving 10.4 million subscribers. The film is 28.30 in length and will air 7/16 & 7/25 at 4:00 p.m. Our charge is \$3,980.


