a. Barbados Industrial Development Corporation:

The New York Office of the Barbados Industrial Development Corporation at Bridgetown continued to function as a promotional arm of the Government of Barbados in the encouragement of industrial development in the country. The main techniques used in industrial investment promotion centred around advertising and related correspondence, business seminars and personal interviews. Normal distribution of promotional literature took place.

b. Barbados Tourist Board:

Travel promotion was the sole activity of the Barbados Tourist Board's New York Office during the period. The Board engaged in customary advertising and circulation of promotional brochures. The major activity of tourist promotion peaked in March 1972 when the Board joined with the Barbados Hotel Association in encouraging summer travel to Barbados in several U.S. Cities.

¹The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual.
