During the period under review, there was no change in the activities of the statutory boards representing the Foreign Principals under Section 10.

The Office of the Barbados Industrial Development Corporation continued to service inquiries relating to industrial opportunities in Barbados by correspondence and distribution of literature. In addition, it conducted seminars in Phoenix, San Diego, San Francisco and Detroit. Advertising in the mass news media and personal interviews completed the office's activities.

The Office of the Barbados Tourist Board was involved primarily in disseminating tourist literature with the aim of motivating and building a rhythm of travel to Barbados. This literature was sent out of the office along with films of Barbados. The office was also engaged on the broad level of educating travel agents, travel writers and travel trade in general on the facilities Barbados has to offer as a holiday destination. The office also held a series of seminars and presentations to put this into effect.

¹The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual. (See Rule 100(a)(9)).
