BARBADOS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

The functions of the New York Office of the Barbados Industrial Development Corporation, as in previous six-month reporting periods, have been to provide an information and consulting service to US businessmen who may be seeking a foreign location for manufacturing facilities. In carrying out those functions, the New York Office's staff has conducted advertising and direct mail programmes, held meetings and interviews in various parts of the U.S.A. and generally promoted Barbados as a place in which to do business through the distribution of printed material.

BARBADOS BOARD OF TOURISM

The Barbados Board of Tourism was involved primarily in disseminating tourist literature with the aim of motivating and building a rhythm of travel to Barbados. This literature along with films on Barbados were sent out of the office. The office was also engaged on the broad level of educating travel agents throughout the country, travel writers and travel trade in general on the facilities Barbados has to offer as a holiday destination. The office also held a series of seminars and presentations in various cities to put this into effect.

¹ The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual.
