BARBADOS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

During the reporting period, the New York Office of the Barbados Industrial Development Corporation continued its efforts at industrial investment promotion by encouraging US businessmen to set up manufacturing concerns in Barbados. Officers held interviews with company officials in various parts of the United States and distributed printed material.

BARBADOS BOARD OF TOURISM

During the period under review, the Barbados Board of Tourism continued its function of educating the travel trade and consumer public on the island's tourism product. This was done mainly through distribution of specific promotional brochures and other display items as well as films. The office also conducted seminars and made audio visual presentations in cities across the USA.

¹The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual. 


