Item 11. Our activities were confined to telephonic requests for information concerning the Sugar Act, i.e., information concerning quota amounts and shipment records. We also corresponded with the Director of the Sugar Division (USDA) concerning quota allocations. We took the position that El Salvador and Guatemala had not been provided with the full quota amounts to which they were entitled under the Sugar Act of 1948. We advised the Department of Agriculture that Nicaragua would be unable to fulfill the entire amount of its 1974 quota. We requested confirmation of quota actions taken with respect to Honduras.

Item 14(a). Expense monies were received for general expenses. A report on disbursements made during the six month period is found in Item 15(a).
