**Re: Merger of Squire Sanders and Patton Boggs**

Dear Ms. Hunt:

Patton Boggs LLP and Squire Sanders LLP have combined effective June 1, 2014. Patton Boggs is registered with the FARA Unit under Registration Number 2165. Squire Sanders Public Advocacy LLC is registered under Registration Number 6063 in connection with its representation of a single foreign principal, the Government of Nicaragua Corporacion de Zonas Francas. We are filing an Amendment to Registration Statement (Form NASD-5) to reflect the combination of the two firms. As noted on the form, the new firm Squire Patton Boggs LLP proposes to use the existing FARA Registration Number of Patton Boggs LLP. Squire Patton Boggs also proposes to use the existing Patton Boggs FARA eFile account number and password for the purpose of submitting future FARA filings.

Patton Boggs has been submitting its bi-annual Supplemental Statements on or before the end of July (to reflect activity during the January – June reporting period), and on or before the end of January (to reflect activity during the July – December reporting period). Squire Patton Boggs proposes to submit its bi-annual Supplemental Statements on this same schedule. Its next report will include FARA-reportable activities conducted on behalf of the Government of Nicaragua Corporacion de Zonas Francas for the three month period April – June.<sup>1</sup>

We have not submitted with this filing the partnership agreement of Squire Patton Boggs. The document is retained in confidence by Squire Patton Boggs as it contains sensitive
