The foreign principal has requested our assistance in facilitating the establishment of a Governing International Fisheries Agreement (GIFA) between the U.S. and Portugal which will permit the principal's members to obtain fishing rights in U.S. waters and our assistance in obtaining fishing permits for Portugal once a GIFA is established. The period of the agreement is indefinite with the principal to pay for services performed at normal hourly rates, and to reimburse the firm for expenses incurred in connection with such services.

- Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

Registrant may engage in the performance of legal and related services on behalf of the foreign principal. Such services may include formal and/or informal advocacy of the principal's interests before U.S. Government agencies, U.S. Regional Fishery Management Councils and the U.S. Congress. Such services may also include advice and counsel with respect to the domestic or foreign fisheries policies of the United States.


