



Dear Mr. Omgba:

We are pleased that you have retained Patton, Boggs & Blow to represent you in connection with the Zaire delegation. My firm and our local bar rules require that our undertaking be set forth in writing, and that is the purpose of this letter.

Patton, Boggs & Blow will represent your interests in the Zaire delegation matter as follows. We will form a delegation from American non-governmental organizations to visit Zaire to discuss, on a confidential basis, the prospects of a peace conference with the main actors which will include, in Zaire, President Mobutu and the protagonists Messrs. Dos Santos and Savimbi and, outside of Zaire, Presidents Mandela, Nujoma, Lissouba, and Chissano. These meetings will be held in confidence, and to preserve the confidentiality of the undertaking, the delegation will not meet with any other persons except American diplomats in Kinshasa, to whom the delegation may talk after the meeting with President Mobutu. Upon its return to the United States, the delegation will be asked to discuss with relevant U.S. Government and Congressional officials the possibility of the moral endorsement of the peace conference by the United States Government.

I will be the partner in my firm responsible for the work done on your behalf. I will be assisted by other partners, principally Steven M. Schneebaum and Jeffrey T. Smith, and by associates and paralegals as I deem appropriate in the circumstances. We will charge you our legal fees based on our standard hourly billing rates in effect when the work is performed. Our hourly rates for attorneys who are likely to do most of the work on this project range from \$200-\$320. My time is billed at \$320 per hour.


