Based on the terms incorporated herein, we agree that Patton Boggs shall receive an initial retainer of \$50,000 in order to begin our work on your behalf. However, you shall replenish the retainer throughout this engagement upon the retainer's depletion. Any travel expenses related to this engagement shall be invoiced separately and paid by you immediately upon the invoice presentation. The term of this engagement is initially one year from the date of signature. The Parties may extend the agreement for a specified further period of time at the end of the initial one year period.



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
