Dear Mr. Accrombessi:

Thank you for retaining Patton Boggs LLP ("Patton Boggs") to counsel the Government of the Gabonese Republic ("Government") on its relations with the United States Government, and to help the Government enhance its image. We look forward to working with you.

To ensure that the Government and we have a common understanding of the terms of our representation and to comply with the rules of professional conduct for the jurisdictions in which we practice, we have enclosed a statement describing the standard terms of engagement for legal services to be provided by Patton Boggs. The terms of engagement cover such matters as our procedure for handling potential conflicts of interest, fees, costs and expenses, billing arrangements and terms of payment. Please review the document carefully to ensure that it comports with your understanding. This letter supplements and modifies the enclosed terms of engagement.

We will be primarily responsible for the work conducted on behalf of the Government and will supervise the lawyers and other professionals who may work on this project. We anticipate that associates, staff attorneys, legal assistants, specialists and/or in-house consultants will assist in the matter. In order to commence work, Patton Boggs is required to register pursuant to the U.S. Foreign Agent Registration Act.

For this engagement, we propose a retainer in the amount of US\$50,000 ("Retainer") against which we will bill our time. As explained more fully in the terms of engagement, we will determine our legal fees based on our standard hourly billing rates in effect when the work is performed and the number of hours worked by each attorney. The Retainer will cover incidental expenses. Significant expenses, such as travel that is authorized by the Government, will not be covered by the Retainer and will instead be billed separately. Whenever the Retainer is nearly depleted, we will submit an invoice to the Government requesting another US\$50,000.

If you agree with these terms and conditions, indicated by the check mark in the standard terms of engagement page, study counter sign in the space provided below on behalf of the Government. If you have any questions about these terms or would like to discuss them, please call the assigned PACS. It is a requirement to proceed with our contracting work on your behalf.

This agreement letter supersedes any previous agreement between Patton Boggs and the Government. The terms and conditions will apply to any future work unless indicated by the Government and a new letter reflecting the different terms and conditions.

I am authorized to represent the Government, and do hereby accept the terms and conditions of this agreement.
