





**The Royal Embassy of Saudi Arabia**

Pursuant to our agreement with Qorvis Communications, we have provided services to the Royal Embassy of Saudi Arabia in respect to the Embassy's relationship with the U.S. Congress. Our activities have consisted of scheduling meetings with Members of Congress and Congressional staffers, attending these meetings, or accompanying an Embassy representative to these meetings, and providing comments and advice regarding the content of Congressional communications. We advised the Embassy on the status of legislation and legislative inquiries of interest to the Royal Kingdom, on the status of Congressional hearings of interest, strategies for dealing with Congress and U.S. government officials, and strategies for improving the U.S.-Saudi bilateral relationship.

**The Government of the State of Qatar.**

We advised the Government of the State of Qatar with respect to its bilateral relationship with the United States Government, including security and commercial issues. We provided advice in connection with official visits to the United States by Qatari officials, economic development initiatives in Qatar; initiatives to establish relationships with American universities; human rights issues; and issues relative to defense cooperation between the United States and Qatar. We also provided comments and advice regarding the content of speeches/remarks and other communications by Qatar officials, and their correspondence with the U.S. Government officials. We also provide legal advice to the Government of Qatar in matters involving international law, commercial investment, litigation and contracts.

**Sociedade Nacional de Combustiveis de Angola / Republic of Angola (SONANGOL)**

Representation of certain interests of Sociedade Nacional de Combustiveis de Angola (SONANGOL) in the United States and, on behalf of Sonangol, advice and assistance to the Government of Angola on defined public policy issues. The principal activities during the period included meetings with representatives of the United States government in the Departments of Commerce, State, Energy, Defense, Treasury and the National Security Council

to form a better understanding of bilateral issues of interest. During this period we also met with senior officials of the International Monetary Fund to form a greater appreciation of issues relating to Angola. We traveled to Luanda, Angola during this period to meet with the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Sonangol and to discuss transparency and related issues with him and with senior officials of the Angolan government. We held discussions in Washington with officials of Trade Development Agency and the Overseas Private Investment Corporation concerning trade and investment opportunities in Angola and with a director of the Export-Import Bank of the United States about credit assistance to Sonangol. We attended meetings with staff and members of the United States Congress to discuss issues of interest relating to Angola. We also arranged, and participated in, a meeting between the Angolan Ambassador to the United States and staff of relevant Congressional committees and members. We assisted the Angolan Ambassador in convening a conference at the Embassy of interested non-governmental organizations to discuss human rights issues. We advised the Angolan Ambassador and representatives of the Angolan government on trade policies and other bilateral issues between Angola and the United States. We held discussions with representatives of the Soros Foundations and officials of Sonangol and the Angolan government on possible initiatives on transparency.

### **Corporate Fund Kazakhstan**

We advised Corporate Fund Kazakhstan (CFK) with respect to its relationship with the western media and the U.S. Government. This included comments and advise on communications between the Republic of Kazakhstan and the media, members of Congress, congressional staff, and certain Executive Branch officials. The principal activity during this period was advice and assistance on media issues including the proposal of certain positive press articles regarding Kazakhstan. We also assisted in responding to negative articles about the country. In addition, we advised CFK and the Embassy of the status of legislation, strategies for addressing those measures, strategies for dealing with Congress and U.S. government officials, and strategies for improving the U.S.-Kazakhstan relationship.
