**Al-Hamar Trading Group**

Registrant assisted the foreign principal in requesting meetings with the U.S. Department of State, seeking a U.S. entry visa, and performing background research for Hamid Al-Ahmar, the owner of the Al-Hamar Trading Group and a Member of the Yemeni Parliament. In the coming months, Mr. Al-Ahmar plans to travel to Washington with a delegation of current and former members of the Yemeni government.

**Government of Albania**

During the first half of 2012, Registrant worked with the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum to plan a special presentation of the documentary *Besa: The Promise*, chronicling the unique history of Albanians who protected Jewish refugees during the Holocaust. Officials from the U.S. State Department and the U.S. Congress attended the event. Registrant also provided analysis of Congressional hearings and met with State Department officials to discuss political and economic developments in Albania.

**The Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan**

There was no reportable activity performed on behalf of the Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan during the reporting period.

**Government of the Republic of Cameroon**

Registrant counseled the foreign principal on several matters involving the U.S. Government. Specifically, Registrant compiled information and analyzed the legal, regulatory, and political requirements of the Millennium Challenge Account (“MCA”) Program. In addition, Registrant advised the foreign principal on how it might achieve compliance with various MCA Program requirements. Registrant also counseled the foreign principal on compliance with the African Growth and Opportunity Act, discussed with U.S. Government officials how the foreign principal might increase its benefits under the trade preference program, and advised the foreign principal on Congressional consideration of extending AGOA. Moreover, Registrant counseled the foreign principal on the legal and political ramifications of being ranked on the Tier 2 Watch List of the U.S. Department of State’s Trafficking in Persons (“TIP”) Report. This included developing and implementing a strategy for the foreign principal to improve its efforts to combat TIP. More broadly, Registrant monitored and advised the foreign principal of various U.S. policy developments.

**Republic of Chad**

There was no reportable activity performed on behalf of the Embassy of the Republic of Chad during this reporting period.

**Embassy of the People's Republic of China**

Registrant counseled the foreign principal on United States Congressional matters. This included compiling information and analyzing the potential legal and political ramifications of passage of the "Currency Exchange Rate Oversight Reform Act" (S. 1619). Registrant also helped monitor Congressional consideration of potential U.S. arms sales to Taiwan, including that related to the "Taiwan Airpower Modernization Act of 2011" (S. 1539 / H.R. 2992). Registrant also monitored the House and Senate National Defense Authorization Acts for Fiscal Year 2013 (H.R. 4310 / S. 3254) and foreign principal-related provisions and amendments thereto including export controls on commercial satellites and related components. In addition, Registrant advised the foreign principal on the "Safeguarding United States Satellite Leadership and Security Act of 2012" (S. 3211) and potential Senate ratification of the United Nations Convention of the Law of the Sea.

**Republic of Croatia**

Registrant analyzed decision by the International Criminal Tribunal for Yugoslavia and briefed Congressional offices on its implications for U.S. military personnel in combat, humanitarian and peacekeeping missions. Registrant urged support for meetings between foreign principal officials and U.S. Government officials. Registrant also advised the foreign principal on U.S. security assistance.

**Embassy of Ecuador**

Registrant counseled the foreign principal on Congressional consideration of the Andean Trade Preferences Act ("ATPA") and the Generalized System of Preferences, set to expire on July 31, 2013. In addition, Registrant helped monitor Congressional consideration of the Fiscal Year 2013 State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs Appropriations, the "Countering Iran in the Western Hemisphere Act of 2012" (H.R. 3783), and related legislation to increase U.S. sanctions against Iran. Registrant also monitored the confirmation proceedings for Ambassadorial nominees Adam Namm and Roberta Jacobson. Moreover, Registrant discussed with U.S. Government officials the status of the foreign principal's benefits under ATPA and the broader bilateral trade relationship. Registrant also monitored and advised the foreign principal on various U.S. policy developments and their potential impact on the bilateral relationship.

**Korea International Trade Association**

There was no reportable activity performed on behalf of the Korea International Trade Association (KITA) during this reporting period.

**Government of Kosova**

During the first half of 2012, Registrant represented the foreign principal on multiple aspects of its relations with the U.S. Government. First, Registrant contacted Congressional officials to detail the political and security situation in northern Kosovo and advocate for continued U.S. and NATO support. Second, Registrant called on Administration and Congressional officials to support the independence and territorial integrity of the foreign principal, particularly relating to diplomatic recognition by other nations and its full sovereignty over ethnic Serb areas in the northern part of the country. Finally, Registrant corresponded with Administration officials to discuss opportunities for U.S. investment in Kosovo.

**The Transitional National Council of Libya**

The registrant counseled the foreign principal on several matters in the U.S. and abroad. Registrant advised the principal, now the new Government of Libya, on how to regain management control over the Libyan people's assets in the US and abroad, to protect these assets for the Libyan people and for use in rebuilding Libya. Some of these assets had been frozen by the US Treasury Department pursuant to Presidential Executive Order and UN Security Council Resolution. Registrant also advised the principal on how to protect those Libyan assets still frozen by U.S. Government, pursuant to Executive Order and UN Security Resolution, to ensure they are held in trust for the benefit of the Libyan people. Registrant also counseled the foreign principal on legal issues in the US and the UN related to the lifting of sanctions, sanctioned individuals and asset recovery. Registrant advised on rule of law, democracy and governance in the US and abroad. Registrant advised on support for elections and for democratic transition in Libya. Registrant advised on the Fiscal Year 2012 and 2013 State-Foreign Operations appropriations legislation. Registrant advised on various other U.S. policy developments and their potential impact on the bilateral relationship with the new government of Libya. Registrant also supported visits of foreign officials of the principal to Washington D.C. by setting up meetings with U.S. Government officials, media and think tanks, and provided legal advice to the foreign principal in a number of areas, including public international law, immigration status for diplomats and foreign diplomats, ongoing investigations and litigation claims against the foreign principal for the illegal acts of the Gaddafi Regime, Embassy contracts, and care for Embassy property and assets. Registrant also advised on various public international law issues related to forming a new successor government, regaining sovereignty, and the UN and treaty obligations of the new government.

**Sovereign Military Hospitaller Order of St. John of Jerusalem of Rhodes and of Malta**

There was no reportable activity performed on behalf of the Sovereign Military Hospitaller Order of St. John of Jerusalem of Rhodes and of Malta during this reporting period.

During the reporting period, Patton Boggs advised the Government of the State of Qatar in regard to its bilateral relationship with the United States, its trade and commerce activities, and legal matters involving the Embassy of the State of Qatar, contractors and Qatari nationals. Patton Boggs also rendered advice to the Embassy concerning its charitable activities in the United States; the exercise of diplomatic functions, including consular visits to, and communications with, Qatari nationals detained in the United States; interpretation of obligations established by treaty; issues of diplomatic immunity; and vendor contracts with the Embassy.

**Royal Embassy of Saudi Arabia**

Registrant counseled the foreign principal on United States legislative and executive branch developments affecting the bilateral relations of the U.S. and Saudi Arabia as well as multi-lateral issues affecting the Middle East and Gulf regions.
