



SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT - SECTION II AMENDMENT

The New Zealand Meat Producers Board is a Statutory Board of New Zealand, with a representative office in New York. It is a Board representing the meat farmers of New Zealand. I, the undersigned, have been temporarily seconded to New York office to manage its affairs.

Primary functions are as follows:-

- (a) To observe, monitor and report on the meat market in the USA and Canada. This function being particularly related to imports of New Zealand meat into the USA and Canada.
- (b) To assist trade inquiries for New Zealand meat.
- (c) To liaise with the New Zealand Embassy, Consulates, and Trade Commissioners, and our attorney, on any developments that might affect New Zealand meat.
- (d) To assist trade and farming visitors from New Zealand.
- (e) To liaise with farmer bodies in the USA and Canada, such as cattle and sheep farmer organisations; and also meat trade associations.
- (f) When requested, to assist the New Zealand Lamb Co., Inc. with promotion and advertising of New Zealand lamb, as a consultant.
