SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT IN ELABORATION OF ITEM 11

The New Zealand Meat Board, whose operational name is Meat New Zealand, is a statutory board of New Zealand with a representative office in metropolitan Washington, DC. It is a board funded by a mandatory checkoff assessed on all cattle, sheep and goats slaughtered in New Zealand. Primary functions are to:

- observe, monitor, and report on the meat market in North America;
- develop and advance Meat New Zealand's positions on matters affecting New Zealand's meat trade with North America; and
- manage generic promotion of New Zealand meat.

These functions being particularly related to imports of New Zealand meat into the USA, Canada, and Mexico.

- A. Monitor market developments through ongoing trade contact and report to New Zealand head office.

Meetings with Washington attorney and other parties to discuss issues such as beef checkoff, mandatory price reporting, Free Trade Agreements and mandatory country of origin labeling.

Attendance at selected conferences.

- B. To assist trade inquiries for New Zealand meat.

Responded to inquirers seeking information on New Zealand meat.

- C. To liaise with the New Zealand embassy, consulates, trade commissioners, and Meat New Zealand's attorney on developments that might affect New Zealand meat.

Kept informed on developments concerning US legislation that might affect imports of beef and lamb from New Zealand including mandatory price reporting, mandatory country of origin labeling and US farm bill.

- D. To assist trade and farmer visitors from New Zealand.

Coordinated visits of NZ-based MNZ staff.

- E. To liaise with farmer bodies in the USA and Canada, such as cattle and sheep farmer organizations, and also meat trade associations.

Attended conventions/meetings with Beef Promotion and Research Board, Meat Importers Council of America, National Cattlemen's Beef Association and American Sheep Industry Association.

- F. To promote the products of the New Zealand meat industry.
