

Tuzex Foreign Trade Corporation, which has its head office in Prague, Czechoslovakia, is an autonomous economic organization established for commercial and foreign trade purposes. The functions and legal status of this type of corporation is set out under the provisions of Act No. 101 dated December 4th, 1963, named the "International Trade Code" and particularly Section 11 which states:

"Czechoslovak juristic persons, particularly foreign trade and international forwarding corporations, answer for the breach of their obligations with their assets and the State does not stand for the obligations of such juristic persons; these juristic persons do not stand for the debts of the State or of another juristic person".



