Fifty percent of the stock of Belgonucleaire is owned by the Government of the Kingdom of Belgium. The remaining fifty percent is owned by privately-owned electric utilities in that country. Thus, action by Belgonucleaire requires Government agreement but the Government, acting alone, can not direct action. The Government has made loans to Belgonucleaire.
