



This letter will confirm the understanding reached between our firm and your two fine associations concerning modification of our agreement with you for legal services performed on your behalf. It was further agreed that the terms of our agreement with you will be subject to review and reevaluation at the end of 1981.


Except as set out in this letter, the terms of our relationship will be governed by the letter of agreement dated April 13, 1979 between your associations and this law firm.




