4. Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

Registrant is to represent Camara de la Industria Aceitera de la Republica Argentina (CIARA) in an investigation by the USTR pursuant to Section 301 of the Trade Act of 1974, as amended. The investigation was initiated by the USTR on the petition of the National Soybean Processors Association and concerns Argentina's export tax on raw soybeans and soybean meal and oil. Registrant is to develop CIARA's legal strategy for the proceeding, prepare and submit a response to the petition and briefs, memoranda, and information on behalf of CIARA. Registrant will also appear in the proceeding on behalf of CIARA and will discuss the issues of the investigation with and make arguments to the other parties to this investigation, including U.S. agencies and officials which participate in Section 301 proceedings under the chairmanship of the USTR. Registrant will also advise Argentinean government officials from time to time of developments in the proceeding and may coordinate CIARA's position with that taken by the Government of Argentina.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

Registrant will appear and file memoranda, briefs, and information in the Section 301 investigation. Registrant will discuss with and make arguments to the parties to the investigation, including U.S. officials and agencies which participate in Section 301 proceedings. Registrant will also discuss developments in the investigation with Argentine government officials and may coordinate CIARA's position with those of the Government of Argentina.

6. Will the activities on behalf of the above foreign principal include political activities as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act?


