



^{1/} Political activity as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act means the dissemination of political propaganda and any other activity which the person engaging therein believes will, or which he intends to, prevail upon, indoctrinate, convert, induce, persuade, or in any other way influence any agency or official of the Government of the United States or any section of the public within the United States with reference to formulating, adopting, or changing the domestic or foreign policies of the United States or with reference to the political or public interests, policies, or relations of a government of a foreign country or a foreign political party.



The Island Territory of Curacao for these presents lawfully represented by its Governor Ornelio Martina, in compliance with article 74, paragraph 2, of the "Eilandenregeling Nederlandse Antillen" (the Constitution of the island territories of the Netherlands Antilles), hereby executing a decision of the Executive Council of the Island Territory of Curacao, dated august 26 1980 no. 6, hereinafter referred to as "Curacao",

and

mr. Eithel HERNANDEZ lawfully representing EITHEL HERNANDEZ ASSOCIATES, in New York, United States of America, hereinafter referred to as "HERNANDEZ",

HAVE ENTERED THE FOLLOWING AGREEMENT:

1. Curacao hereby agrees with HERNANDEZ that HERNANDEZ will direct the Curacao Tourist Board in New York in the United States of America, for a period extending from january 1st, 1981 to December 31st, 1983 and HERNANDEZ accepts this agreement under the following conditions.
2. HERNANDEZ agrees with Curacao that HERNANDEZ will direct the Curacao Tourist Board to the exclusion of all other bussiness promoting as such tourism from the markets of the United States of America (mainland) and Canada to the island of Curacao.

For its services HERNANDEZ is to receive a management fee of US \$ 3.368,75 (three thousand threehundred and sixty eight dollars and seventy five cents) per month, payable in the first five days of each month during continuance of this agreement.

3. HERNANDEZ will be in charge of all financial matters of the Curacao Tourist Board.

HERNANDEZ will not make any expenses for the Curacao Tourist

Board which are not in accordance with the yearly budget of the Curacao Tourist Board, as approved by Curacao.

The budget of the Curacao Tourist Board will include among other items an amount of money to cover salary expenses for HERNANDEZ's employees working at the Curacao Tourist Board in New York.

4. HERNANDEZ will render to Curacao a monthly account of the expenditures made on behalf of the Curacao Tourist Board in accordance with the instructions provided by Curacao.
5. If the services rendered by HERNANDEZ have been satisfactory to the judgement of Curacao, HERNANDEZ can enter into negotiations with Curacao to adjust the management fee mentioned in article 2 in order to change it two months before the end of each calendar year.
6. HERNANDEZ agrees to provide Curacao with a monthly report containing detailed information on the activities deployed by HERNANDEZ in directing the Curacao Tourist Board. It is expressly agreed that in case HERNANDEZ does not fulfil this charge, Curacao shall have the right to terminate this agreement, after a period decided upon by Curacao, after previous notice in writing.

In order to prevent misunderstanding of the abovementioned clause it is hereby stated that the monthly report of the marketing and sales activities of the Curacao Tourist Board must be sent to Curacao within the first (fifteen) days of the subsequent month, in witness whereof the date of the postmark will suffice.
7. While HERNANDEZ is directing the Curacao Tourist Board, it is forbidden to HERNANDEZ or its employees, to demand, solicit or accept reimbursements, rewards, gifts or promises from third persons without the specific approval of Curacao.


It is strictly and unconditionally forbidden to HERNANDEZ and its employees to accept bribes.

8. In case of non-fulfilment or improper handling of the assignments contained in this agreement and in case of appointment of Receivers for HERNANDEZ, this agreement shall be dissolved "de jure" without intervention of the judge, after written notice of Curacao of his decision to terminate this agreement as of the date mentioned therein.
9. The validity and interpretation of this agreement and of each clause and part hereof shall be governed by the law of the Netherlands Antilles.


