


It is agreed between Messerschmitt-Bölkow-Blohm (MBB) and Mr. Hyman Fine, representing Hyman Fine and Associates, Ltd. (HFA), that:


1. Mr. Fine will act as a consultant to MBB for questions regarding U.S. air defense programs and requirements, both current and proposed, having the potential for a business opportunity for MBB.
2. HFA will receive a monthly retainer under this agreement of \$ 1.500.00, payable monthly.
3. HFA will receive, in addition to compensation under item 2, reimbursement each month for necessary out-of-pocket expenses incurred on behalf of MBB. Extraordinary travel, such as to California or to Europe, will be performed only with the prior approval of MBB (Mr. Wossagk, Mr. Klein, or Mr. Kuhlo).
