

Dear Mr. Federico:

Thank you for contacting Hill and Knowlton to assist you regarding a meeting with Vice President Gore and Mr. Osvaldo Mercuri, President of the Assembly of Deputies of Buenos Aires. We believe that we can be of assistance in regard to the meeting. However, you should understand that our best efforts do not guarantee that such a meeting will be scheduled.

In order to begin our efforts on your behalf we must have a signed contract. I hope you understand that since the same level of work by Hill and Knowlton is necessary whether we are granted a meeting or not, we require a signed contract and payment whether or not the appointment is granted.

Please be assured that Hill and Knowlton has the personnel to pursue an appointment with the Vice President. I have attached the biographies of some of the individuals who will assist in our effort on your behalf. I, myself, served as Special Assistant to President Clinton where I worked closely with the staff of the Vice President. Tom Hoog, Chairman of Hill and Knowlton Public Affairs, has over thirty years public affairs experience and an equally strong background on both federal and state political campaigns. Gary Hymel, Jeff Trammell and Jerry Grant are other individuals in the firm who will assist in our effort. I have attached a copy of our biographies for you to review.

Because of the shortness of time, I have taken the liberty of enclosing a copy of our standard contract for your review and signature. The contract fee for our services is \$10,000 payable upon signing and before we begin our work. Of the \$10,000 fee, we anticipate that \$7500 staff work will be required in preparation for the meeting and \$2500 will be required for assistance with the meeting itself. Obviously if no meeting is held we will not incur the second amount and the \$2500 will be refunded.


