The registrant has been engaged by Banco Central to provide legal advice concerning the payment of the international financial obligations of Argentine entities and with respect to the blocking orders recently entered by the United Kingdom and by the Argentine Republic and related commercial, economic and financial matters and to provide appropriate legal representation in the United States in connection therewith. As necessary for the performance of such services, the registrant will from time to time contact and meet with officials of the United States government, or agencies thereof, who are responsible for the conduct of the policies of the government, or such agencies, pertaining to these matters.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.
