

Wilmer, Cutler & Pickering will assist the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany in connection with its negotiation of an agreement with the United States Government until March 1, 1986. For its services, Wilmer, Cutler & Pickering will be compensated according to the time spent by individual lawyers for their work on the project, computed at fixed hourly rates which will not exceed the hourly rates normally charged by the firm, plus direct charges incurred, up to a maximum of \$15,000.

4. Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

Lawyers with Wilmer, Cutler & Pickering will give legal advice to the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany in connection with the latter's negotiation of an agreement with the United States Government covering German participation in the Strategic Defense Initiative research program, including advice on the consequences under U.S. law of alternative provisions being considered by the German Government. This representation may include discussions with Executive Branch officials.
