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A G R E E M E N T

TOURISM CORPORATION BONAIRE, established at the Kaya Lib. Simon Bolivar # 12, Bonaire, Netherlands Antilles, hereinafter to be called TCB, and legally represented by its Director, Geronimo Pioters,

and

KAREN WEINER ESCALERA ASSOCIATES, INC., hereinafter also to be referred to as "KWE", established at 104 Fifth Avenue 11th floor, New York, N.Y. 10011 USA, at these presents duly and legally represented by its President, Karen Weiner Escalera.

WHEREAS, TCB and KWE wish to enter into an agreement whereby KWE serves as the North American Public Relations Counsel on terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, and as also contained the Public Relations action plan presented by KWE on January 4, 1993.

THEREFORE, TCB and KWE, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

DUTIES OF KWE

KWE will advise TCB and provide counseling on the Tourism Public Relations aspects of its policies. This will include but will not be limited to the following:

1. Media Relations -- KWE will plan and implement a national trade and consumer public relations program for Bonaire, targeted to key media throughout the U.S., including the following activities.
 - * Writing and production of a Bonaire press kit, and updating it with new material as changes occur.
 - * Developing, coordinating and hosting two group trips of travel media to Bonaire. (Would mainly include journalists from "general" travel media, but also select reporters representing special interest media).

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* Year-long trade media relations activities,
including the following:

- Research, write, distribute and place news releases to the travel and meeting trade media.
- Develop exclusive story ideas for targeted major media and placement of major articles.
- Initiate press interviews for Bonaire tourism principals in combination with their sales and promotional visits around the country.
- Provide public relations support to tour operators featuring Bonaire.
- Serve as press spokesperson to trade media.

* Year-long consumer media relations activities,
including the following:

- Research, write and circulate news releases to national consumer media with targeted releases aimed at specific feature writers.
- Place major feature articles with the travel media, and also specialty media such as those covering scuba diving, photography, sailing, fishing, naturalism, environmentalism, etc.
- Develop broadcast exposure where appropriate and desirable for Bonaire.
- Initiate individual media visits to attract coverage by journalists unable to attend regular press trips.
- Serve as spokesperson to national consumer media as needed.

- Provide marketing communications counsel relating to Bonaire's national and local publicity needs.
 - Monitor all publicity results; advise and handle merchandising of results, i.e. article reprints for press kits, clip books, etc.
2. Special Interest Promotions -- KWE will develop and execute themed events and promotions tie-ins with organizations and/or companies representing the island's key special interest attractions, such as
- * Bonaire's Birdwatching olympics -- Develop joint-promotion with major U.S. manufacturer of scuba diving and snorkeling equipment. Plan and execute a targeted public relations campaign to publicize the promotion in national special interest and trade media.
 - * Bonaire's family months -- Explore ways to present Bonaire to environmentally conscious consumers as one of the first "Green" vacation destinations for the nineties.

STAFFING

KWE will provide professional staffing, including limited management time plus one account executive whose principal assignment and first responsibility will be undertaking the duties of this agreement. TCB has the right to give notice to KWE of their disapproval of the account executive. Upon written notification of TCB's disapproval, KWE will remove the account executive from TCB's account.

SERVICE FEES

For service under this agreement, TCB will pay KWE a service fee of US\$4,000.= monthly. office rent, taxes and utilities will be for the account of KWE.

OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSES

TCB will reimburse KWE for all reasonable out-of-pocket disbursements made in the performance of its duties under this agreement for a maximum not exceeding US\$1,250.= monthly unless prior approval is obtained by KWE from TCB.

Out-of-pocket expenses involving third-party suppliers such as printing, outside mailings, art work, photography, etc. will be rebilled by KWE to TCB at net cost plus standard agency supervision and administration fee of 17.65%. Other items, such as postage, travel, luncheons with clients, etc. will be rebilled at net cost with no markup.

TRAVEL EXPENSES

It is agreed that complimentary "space available" air transportation, hotel accommodations, meals and transportation will be arranged for KWE personnel when travelling on official Government business. If complimentary status cannot be arranged for any reason, TCB will be invoiced for costs incurred, only if these expenses have been made after previous approval of the Bonaire Government.

TELEPHONE

Back-up on telephone calls made for TCB will be provided via the telephone company's monthly computerized billings.

RECORDS AND RECORD KEEPING

KWE will maintain records of all out-of-pocket expenditures incurred on behalf of TCB. KWE will be prepared to supply any supporting detail required by TCB. Authorization for major projects and major operating activities for amounts in excess of US\$500.00 will be obtained in advance before commitments are made. Whenever possible, photocopies of original invoices for expenses incurred on behalf of TCB will be provided.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Billing will be done monthly for the previous month's expenses and charges and for the following month's service fee.

LIABILITY

KWE shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless TCB and its officials, directors, agents and employees from and against any and all actions, costs, claims, losses, expenses, and/or damages, including attorneys' fees arising out of or resulting from the performance of the services to be performed by KWE hereunder providing however, TCB shall indemnify and hold harmless KWE from and against all losses, claims, damages, liabilities and expenses (including attorneys' fees) arising out of information, reports or data furnished to KWE by TCB.

TERM OF AGREEMENT

The term of this agreement will be for a period of one year commencing January 1, 1993, and ending December 31, 1993. This agreement will automatically be renewed with a cost of living increase based on the CPI for successive one-year periods unless either party notifies the other in writing at least 90 days prior to the expiration date of any such period of their desire not to have the agreement renewed.

Notwithstanding the above, either party may terminate this agreement immediately if the other party defaults in the performance of its contractual obligations.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Netherlands Antilles law shall be applicable on this agreement. Any controversy of claim arising out of or relating to this agreement or the breach thereof, shall be settled by the court of first instance in Bonaire, Netherlands Antilles or higher Netherlands Antilles judicial instances.

Thus agreed upon in duplicate on this 1st day of January 1993.
