


CONTRACT

The Embassy of Japan, 2520 Massachusetts Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. (hereinafter referred to as the "Embassy"), and Saunders and Company, 1050 Duke Street, Alexandria, VA (hereinafter referred to as "Saunders") have agreed as follows:

1. Saunders agrees to provide the Embassy with advice and counsel on systems for communicating Japanese views to Congress and business leaders during the period 1 April 1991 through 31 March 1992.
2. The Embassy agrees to pay Saunders U.S. \$6,250 (Six-thousand Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars). This payment shall be made in four parts: U.S. \$1,563 (One Thousand Five Hundred and Sixty-three Dollars) at the end of June, U.S. \$1,563 (One Thousand Five Hundred and Sixty-three Dollars) at the end of September, U.S. \$1,562 (One Thousand Five Hundred and Sixty-two Dollars) at the end of December, and U.S. \$1,562 (One Thousand Five Hundred and Sixty-two Dollars) at the end of March.
3. This contract shall come into force as of the first day of April 1991, and shall be in effect until March 31, 1992, on the condition that the Diet approves the budget of fiscal year 1991 in addition to the already approved provisional budget.

In witness of the above agreement, Minister Seiichiro Noboru, representing the Embassy of Japan, and Mr. Steven R. Saunders, of Saunders and Company, have signed hereunder.
