



Dear Mr. Mehissou:

A follow-up letter to our conversation and a memorandum of agreement and understanding.

van Kloberg and Associates, Ltd. will assist the Embassy of the Republic of Benin as directed and pertaining to Prime Minister Soglo's visit to Washington, D.C. June 26 - June 30, 1990.

Specifically, van Kloberg Associates will assist:

(1) In preparing and issuing press release(s) announcing the Prime Minister's visit, and the relevant issues surrounding the visit.

(2) In preparing a Press Packet to be provided to journalists and others involved with the Prime Minister's visit.

(3) In coordinating and inviting journalists, (print, radio and TV) for the press breakfast to be held on Friday, June 29, 1990. The specific goal is to attract as many qualified journalists as possible. van Kloberg & Associates will follow-up to ensure that the Embassy receives all copies of articles published.

(4) In drafting and sending opinion articles, Letters-to-the-Editor, etc. to be published in prominent newspapers.

(5) In arranging for one-on-one interviews for the Prime Minister with prominent members of the media.

(6) In assisting the Protocol Coordinator of the House

Foreign Affairs Committee in inviting Congressmen to attend the meeting with the Foreign Affairs Committee and Congressional Black Caucus on June 27th at 4:30.


(7) In arranging for a video crew to record the various events during the Prime Minister's visit.

(8) In arranging a meeting for the Prime Minister with prominent members of the American business community. A tentative time is set for June 29, at 3:00.

No actions will be taken without prior approval and consultation with Mr. Mehissou, and no materials will be disseminated without approval.


