

Privacy Act Statement. Every registration statement, short form registration statement, supplemental statement, exhibit, amendment, dissemination report, copy of political propaganda or other document or information filed with the Attorney General under this act is a public record open to public examination, inspection and copying during the posted business hours of the Registration Unit in Washington, D.C. One copy is automatically provided to the Secretary of State pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Act, and copies of such documents are routinely made available to other agencies, departments and Congress pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Act. Finally, the Attorney General transmits an annual report to the Congress on the Administration of the Act which lists the names of all agents and the nature, sources and content of the political propaganda disseminated or distributed by them. This report is available to the public.

Public reporting burden for this collection of information is estimated to average .49 hours per response, including the time for reviewing instructions, searching existing data sources, gathering and maintaining the data needed, and completing and reviewing the collection of information. 



van Kloberg & Associates, Ltd. is retained by the Embassy of El Salvador to provide government affairs and public relations services.

ACTIVITIES PROVIDED BY VAN KLOBERG & ASSOCIATES

vKA activities may include but are not limited to the following:

1. Prepare draft letters, for the Ambassador's signature, to members of the Administration and Congress -- i.e., to retiring members who still can be helpful to El Salvador; to current members who have been supportive; to current members whose support is sought; to new members of Congress (immediately following the election); and to those appointed to leadership positions on congressional committees.
2. Arrange for articles on El Salvador in leading publications which will highlight current events and elaborate on the country's efforts to carry out the terms of the peace accords and assure peace and stability. Toward this end, vKA will arrange interviews of the Ambassador by key journalists and engage in other media relations.

AUTHORITY AND LIAISON

Controlling authority for this agreement rests with the President of van Kloberg & Associates and with El Salvador's Ambassador to the United States. van Kloberg & Associates has no authority to enter into any contracts on behalf of El Salvador.

PERIOD OF SERVICE

vKA will undertake the above activities over a two-month period, beginning October 15 and ending December 14, 1992.


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FEES AND EXPENSES

Retainer -- Standard time charges for vKA principals and associates will be covered by a monthly retainer fee of \$5,000, payable October 14 and November 14 (for a total of \$10,000).

Expenses -- Expenses previously authorized by the Ambassador, such as courier, entertainment, and printing would be in addition to the retainer fee. They would be billed and payable monthly.
