

Privacy Act Statement. The agent will implement the assignments mentioned in #4 by: attending formal hearings, preparing testimony, delivering testimony before the U.S. Congress and Executive branches; attending and participating in meetings and programs of trade associations; preparing for and participating in negotiations with the U.S. Congress and Executive; informing the principal of developments of importance in the U.S. and worldwide; and attending meetings to advise principal of the above.


